



Driving conditions in South Australia are varied. Take care when travelling in remote areas during summer,

as temperatures in Outback Australia can reach over 40°C. Avoid driving after dark as cattle and wildlife often congregate alongside outback highways at night. Major roads on Kangaroo Island are sealed, however the majority of roads are unsealed and require reduced speed and caution. Travellers should drive at a speed that suits the road, vehicle and weather conditions.

### **Beach Safety**

Australia has some of the world's best beaches, however care and caution should be exercised at all times. Please remember to swim between the red and yellow flags and listen to instructions from lifesavers and lifeguards.

# 1. Barossa and Clare Valley Wine Region

Take your tastebuds on a journey in the Barossa and Clare Valley. With over 180 wineries and 110 cellar doors, there's so much choice when it comes to exploring these famed wine regions. Chat to winemakers and sample their wines at cellar doors such as Penfolds and Sevenhill Cellars. Meet artisan food producers, try their locally made wares and hear about the region they love. (see pages 10, 13 and 36 for details)

### 2. Murray River

Sample the waterfront way of life around the mighty Murray River, Australia's longest. There is no better way to experience the Murray than on an extended river cruise. Travel past magnificent sandstone cliffs, rich wetlands and towering gum trees. (see pages 13, 20 and 21 for details)

### 3. Eyre Peninsula

For a blend of wildlife, seafood, coast and outback, head to the Eyre Peninsula. Hand feed tuna, swim with sea lions and dolphins or cage dive with Great White sharks. Further inland, rocky ranges, vast salt lakes and desert plains provide a magical contrast to the coast. (see pages 14, 18, 19 and 45 for details)

### 4. Coober Pedy

With over 70 opal fields, Coober Pedy is known as the opal capital of the world. Experience digging for opals, stay in underground accommodation and visit underground museums and churches. (see page 47 for details)





### 5. Wilpena Pound

Explore the many tracks and trails of the Ikara-Flinders Ranges National Park leading to places such as Wilpena Pound, a magnificent natural amphitheatre rich in native flora and fauna. (see pages 12 and 49 for details)

### 6. Kangaroo Island

Get up close and personal with a wide range of Australian native animals in their natural habitat on Kangaroo Island. Sample some of the amazing Kangaroo Island produce – try honey, cheeses, wines, gin, oysters and King George whiting. View the outstanding scenery, from the natural sculptures of Remarkable Rocks to the beautiful natural photo frame that is Admiral's Arch and the giant sand dune known as Little Sahara. ### 7. Victor Harbor

Enjoy this seaside town on the Fleurieu Peninsula where sand, surf and wildlife encounters beckon. Travel by horse-drawn tram over the causeway to Granite Island, home to Little penguins. ### 8. Adelaide Hills

An easy 20 minute drive from Adelaide will have you in the Adelaide Hills. Take in Mt Lofty Summit for its panoramic views of Adelaide. Move on to Hahndorf, a historic German village. ### 9. Adelaide Central Market
