5 Day Red Centre Highlights Uluru (Ayers Rock) to Adelaide



HIGHLIGHTS:

- Uluru sunset and sunrise
- Kata Tjuta

Day 1: Uluru (Ayers Rock)

On arrival at Ayers Rock Airport transfer to your hotel. Travel to the mystical 36 domes of Kata Tjuta and spend time at the base of Walpa Gorge. Late afternoon, enjoy a glass of wine and nibbles while watching the changing colours of Uluru at sunset. Overnight at Voyages Desert Gardens Hotel, Ayers Rock Resort.

Day 2: Uluru (Ayers Rock)

Rise early and return to Uluru to watch the amazing sunrise. Tour the base of Uluru, before a guided walk to Mutitjulu waterhole. Visit the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre and learn about Aboriginal culture before travelling to Alice Springs. Spend the next two nights at Double Tree by Hilton Alice Springs.

Day 3: Alice Springs

This morning, enjoy a guided tour into magnificent Standley Chasm, a deep red cleft rising 80 metres. See the immense cliffs of quartzite at Simpsons Gap. Enjoy a light lunch before returning to Alice Springs. (BL)

Day 4: The Ghan – Alice Springs to Adelaide

Enjoy a free morning in Alice Springs before transferring to The Ghan for the overnight journey to Adelaide. Take advantage of a Short Stop in Manguri and marvel at the Outback night sky. (BD)

Day 5: Adelaide

Enjoy breakfast on board The Ghan before arriving in Adelaide. (B)

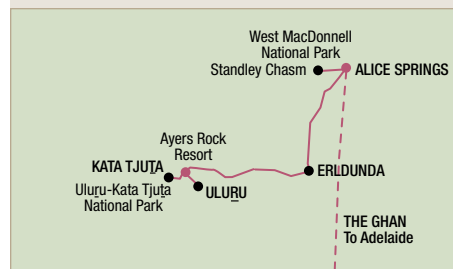

6 Day Highlights of Kakadu Darwin to Adelaide

Day 1: Darwin

Make your own way to Darwin and check-in to Vibe Hotel Darwin.

Day 2: Darwin to Kakadu National Park

Depart Darwin and travel across the Adelaide River and deep into Kakadu National Park. Take a guided walk to Nourlangie Rock. After lunch, join a guided cruise on the Yellow Water Billabong. Overnight at Mercure Kakadu Crocodile Hotel. (BL)

Day 3: Kakadu National Park to Darwin

Travel by 4WD to Ubirr to see superbly preserved Aboriginal rock art. Board the Guluyambi Cultural cruise on the East Alligator River and with special permission, take a short walk into Arnhem Land (conditions permitting). Stop at Bowali Visitor Centre before returning to Darwin. Overnight at Vibe Hotel Darwin. (L)

Day 4: The Ghan – Darwin to Alice Springs

Transfer to Darwin railway station. Depart on The Ghan this morning, stopping at Katherine where you can enjoy an Off Train Excursion of Katherine Gorge. Re-board The Ghan for the overnight journey to Alice Springs. (RD)

Day 5: The Ghan – Alice Springs to Adelaide

Arrive in Alice Springs this morning, where you can enjoy free time or join an Off Train Excursion of Alice Springs. Stop in Manguri and take in the beauty of the Outback night sky. Overnight on board The Ghan. (BD)

Day 6: Adelaide

Enjoy a final breakfast on board the train before arriving in Adelaide around lunch time. (B)

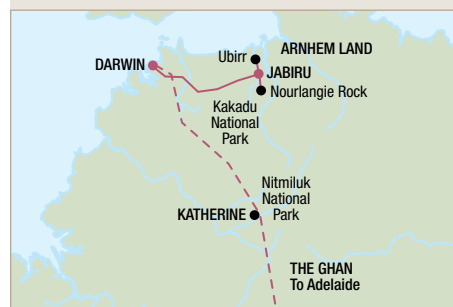

7 Day Top End and Coober Pedy Darwin to Adelaide

Day 1: Darwin

Make your own way to Darwin and check in to the Vibe Hotel Darwin for the next two nights.

Day 2: Litchfield National Park

After breakfast, join the Litchfield Waterfalls tour. Spend the day exploring Litchfield National Park's spectacular waterfalls. (BL)

Day 3: The Ghan – Darwin to Alice Springs

Join the Ghan this morning and travel south to Katherine where you can enjoy an Off Train Excursion at Katherine Gorge. Re-board The Ghan for your overnight journey to Alice Springs. (BLD)

Day 4: The Ghan – Alice Springs to Manguri

On arrival in Alice Springs, join an Off Train Excursion before re-boarding the train for your journey to Manguri. Arrive in Manguri and transfer to the Desert Cave Hotel in Coober Pedy where you will stay for the next three nights. (BD)

Day 5: Coober Pedy

Tour the famous underground town, hear about its history and precious water supplies. Visit a working opal field to see opal mining methods and experience the Breakaways, a range of colourful sandstone outcrops. (B)

Day 6: Coober Pedy

Today tour the breakaway country of the Painted Desert (Arckaringa Hills), an area of spectacular colourful hills created over 80 million years. (BD)

Day 7: Coober Pedy to Adelaide

After breakfast, explore a working opal mine and learn about the various styles of opal mining at the Opal Quest Mine. In the afternoon transfer to Coober Pedy airport for your flight to Adelaide. (B)

Day 1: Darwin

Arrive in Darwin and check-in to Vibe Hotel Darwin.

Day 2: The Ghan – Darwin to Alice Springs

Join The Ghan this morning and head south to Katherine. Enjoy an Off Train Excursion of Katherine Gorge then depart in the late afternoon for the overnight journey on board The Ghan to Alice Springs. (BLD)

Day 3: Alice Springs

Arrive in Alice Springs late morning and check-in to your hotel. Overnight at Lasseters Hotel. (B)

Day 4: Alice Springs to Uluru (Ayers Rock)

Board the coach for a three day exploration of the Red Centre. The afternoon is spent touring the amazing 36 rock domes of Kata Tjuta, before travelling to the Uluru sunset viewing area to watch the spectacular sunset over Uluru. Overnight at Voyages Desert Gardens Hotel, Ayers Rock Resort. (B)

Day 5: Uluru (Ayers Rock) to Kings Canyon

Wake early to view sunrise at Uluru before exploring the base area. In the afternoon travel to Kings Canyon. Overnight at Kings Canyon Resort.

Day 6: Kings Canyon to Alice Springs

This morning join an optional guided climb to the rim of Kings Canyon for marvellous views of Watarrka National Park. An easier walk along the canyon floor is also available. Enjoy lunch at Kings Creek Station (own expense) before travelling back to Alice Springs. Overnight at Lasseters Hotel.

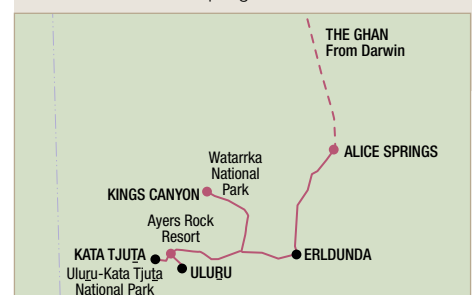

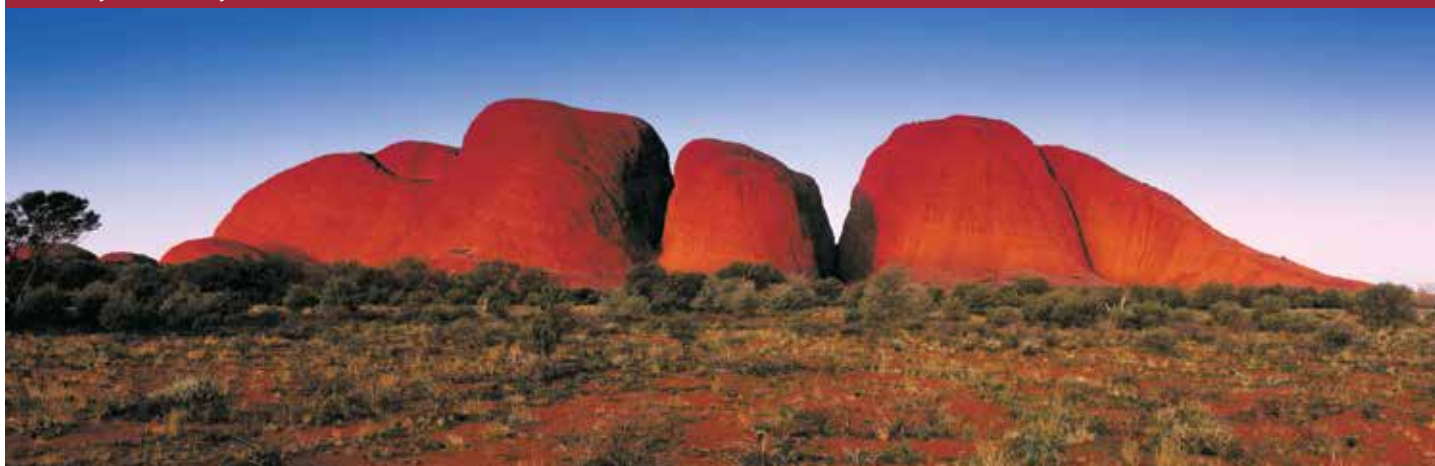

Day 1: The Ghan – Adelaide to Alice Springs

Join The Ghan in Adelaide and enjoy a light lunch as the train travels north towards the Spencer Gulf and Port Augusta. Overnight on board The Ghan. (LD)

Day 2: Alice Springs

Wake up to spectacular views of the heart of Australia as you travel towards Alice Springs. Arrive in Alice Springs in the afternoon to transfer to your hotel. Overnight at Lasseters Hotel. (B)

Day 3: Alice Springs to Uluru (Ayers Rock)

Depart Alice Springs on a four day tour of the Red Centre, stopping at the camel farm on the way to Ayers Rock Resort. Watch the sun set over Uluru before a barbecue dinner under the stars. Stay the next two nights at Voyages Desert Gardens Hotel, Ayers Rock Resort. (BD)

This morning is at leisure to relax or join an optional tour. In the afternoon, travel to the breathtaking Kings Canyon. Overnight at Kings Canyon Resort.

Day 6: Kings Canyon to Alice Springs

Day 11: Darwin

Enjoy a relaxing morning before seeing the highlights of Darwin on an afternoon City Sights tour. Tour the East Point Reserve, see the lush Botanic Gardens and explore the museum and art gallery. (B)

Day 12: Darwin to Kakadu National Park

After boarding the coach depart Darwin and head east in to World Heritage Listed Kakadu National Park. Take a guided walk to Nourlangie Rock to view the ancient galleries of Aboriginal rock art. After lunch, join a guided cruise on the Yellow Water Billabong, keeping a look out for Saltwater crocodiles. Overnight at Mercure Kakadu Crocodile Hotel. (BL)

Day 13: Kakadu National Park to Darwin

Travel by 4WD to see Aboriginal rock art at Ubirr, before joining an Aboriginal guide on a Guluyambi Cultural cruise along the East Alligator River. Return to Darwin and overnight at Vibe Hotel Darwin. (L)

Day 14: Darwin

Your Northern Territory adventure concludes this morning upon check-out from the hotel. (B)
