Exploring the Central Queensland Coast is a rollercoaster ride of experiences.

Mackay's tropical city centre combines dining and shopping with lovely architecture. Down by the marina there are restaurants and bars overlooking the ocean and the coastline is dotted with dozens of sun drenched beaches.

Central Queensland's Capricorn region stretches from the Southern Great Barrier Reef and the Capricorn Coast in the east to Emerald, the Sapphire Gemfields and spectacular Carnarvon Gorge in the west.

Rockhampton is the gateway to the coast and the outback. Known as the Beef Capital of Australia you can enjoy the best steak and even attend the weekly rodeos. The historical architecture has captured the hearts of many visitors boasting the longest National Trust Heritage Street in Australia. Travel north and you're at the Capricorn Coast, including 13 beaches, venture a little further to the rugged Byfield National Park, or head inland to discover Carnarvon National Park, with Aboriginal rock art and delicate ferns amidst towering sandstone cliffs. Capricorn has one of the most spectacular bay of islands in Queensland. Heron, Lady Elliot and Wilson Island are the perfect island escape. Keppel Bay is made up of some 20 islands – after a short 30 minute ferry transfer from the mainland, you'll be snorkelling and exploring one of the most spectacular sections of the Great Barrier Reef.

Gladstone is the gateway to the southern reef, and from here you can day trip to Lady Musgrave Island and Fitzroy Lagoon for some spectacular snorkelling and diving.

With the contrast of sunbathing on secluded white beaches and swimming in aqua-blue waters to scrambling through underground caves and exploring grounds where our ancestors once roamed, the Central Queensland Coast is the perfect place to unwind and let go, connect with nature, and each other.

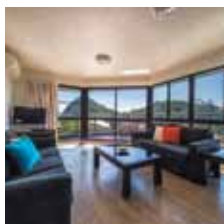

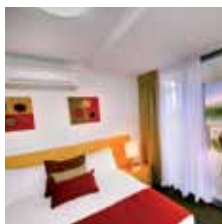

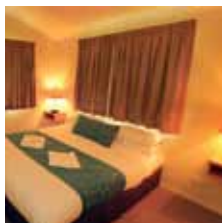
