Marvel at the tiered waterfall at King Cascade, on the Prince Regent River and take a thrilling ride through the Horizontal Falls. Spot crocodiles along the Mitchell River and explore the beaches and ancient rock art on Bigge Island. Just sit back, relax and enjoy the breathtaking scenery that will surround you.

A whole new world of underwater wonder is yours to enjoy at Rowley Shoals Marine Park, 300 kilometres west of Broome. The coral atolls, clear lagoons and incredible marine life are exceptional. Take a dive on Clerke or Mermaid Reef and be on the lookout for everything from colourful coral gardens to various fish species. Come face to face with sea turtles, manta rays and dolphins. It's an underwater playground.

After a full day of exploring the wilderness, dine on sumptuous fresh food and watch the spectacular Kimberley sunset.
