4 Day Kimberley Gorges Broome to Broome

Travel along part of the Gibb River Road to some of the most spectacular gorges in the Kimberley, including Bell Gorge, Galvans Gorge, Windjana Gorge and Geikie Gorge.

Day 1: Broome via Derby to Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge (442km)

Collect your car from Broome and drive to Derby, visit the Boab Prison Tree before beginning your adventure on the Gibb River Road. The destination is Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge overlooking the King Leopold Escarpment, your accommodation for the next two nights. (D)

Day 2: Bell Gorge and Galvans Gorge

Spend the day exploring some of the Kimberley's most scenic gorges. Enjoy hiking and swimming beneath the waterfall in Bell Gorge, see rock art in Galvans Gorge or swim at Barnett River Gorge. (BD)

Day 3: Windjana Gorge and Tunnel Creek to Fitzroy Crossing (290km)

Head to Windjana Gorge National Park with its 300 metre high cliffs, white sand and Freshwater crocodiles on the banks of the Lennard River. Travel to Tunnel Creek and wade through the 750 metre long

tunnel. Continue on to Fitzroy Crossing. Overnight at Fitzroy River Lodge. (B)

Day 4: Fitzroy Crossing to Broome (395km)

Discover the beauty of Geikie Gorge National Park today with a ranger or Aboriginal guided cruise through the gorge (own expense). Return to Broome. The 4WD is booked until the following day and should be dropped off by the same time it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

5 Day Kimberley Discovery Broome to Kununurra

Discover the Kimberley region's ancient landscape of stunning rivers and gorges and the signature Bungle Bungle Range.

Day 1: Broome to Fitzroy Crossing (395km)

Collect your car from Broome and head east into the Kimberley to Fitzroy Crossing, gateway to the spectacular Geikie Gorge National Park, some 20 kilometres away.

Regular boat trips are available on the spectacular gorge and are well worth the trip (own expense). Overnight at Fitzroy River Lodge.

Day 2: Fitzroy Crossing to Halls Creek (290km)

Head to the town of Halls Creek, the site of Western Australia's first gold discovery in 1885. Today, the town serves as a service centre for modern day mining ventures. Overnight at Kimberley Hotel, Halls Creek.

Day 3: Halls Creek to Kununurra (361km)

Travel north through the Kimberley, past the Bungle Bungle Range to Kununurra. The largest diamond mine in the world, the Argyle Diamond Mine, is in the area and tours are available through the mine (own expense). Overnight at Kununurra Lakeside Resort.

Day 4: Kununurra

Day at leisure to explore this fascinating area. Helicopter and 4WD tours operate from Kununurra into the Bungle Bungle Range (own expense). Overnight at Kununurra Lakeside Resort. (B)

Day 5: Kununurra

A free day to discover more of Kununurra. The vehicle is available all day and should be dropped off tomorrow by the same time as it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges. (B)

8 Day Great Northern Adventure Broome to Darwin

Travel through the Kimberley from Broome to Darwin via Kununurra, following the Great Northern Highway. This alternative to the Gibb River Road doesn't require a 4WD, but check road conditions before you travel.

Day 1: Broome to Fitzroy Crossing (390km)

Collect your car from Broome and drive to Fitzroy Crossing. Ranger and Aboriginal guided cruises through nearby Geikie Gorge National Park operate from April to October (own expense). Overnight at Fitzroy River Lodge.

Day 2: Fitzroy Crossing to Halls Creek (288km)

Drive to Halls Creek, the site of Western Australia's first gold rush and the access point for a number of natural attractions including China Wall and Caroline's Pool. Overnight at Kimberley Hotel, Halls Creek.

Day 3: Halls Creek to Kununurra (359km)

Travel via Turkey Creek to Kununurra, a vibrant town and hub of the East Kimberley. Scenic flights over the Bungle Bungle Range are available from Turkey Creek (own expense). Overnight at Kununurra Lakeside Resort.

Day 4: Kununurra

Consider a tour to the Argyle Diamond Mine with a scenic flight over Lake Argyle and the Bungle Bungles, or cruise on the Ord River from Kununurra to Lake Argyle (own expense).

Head to Kelly's Knob Lookout to watch a spectacular Kimberley sunset. Overnight at Kununurra Lakeside Resort. **(B)**

Day 5: Kununurra to Katherine (520km)

Depart Kununurra and enjoy a stop at Lake Argyle before heading across the Northern Territory border, journey via Timber Creek and Victoria River to Katherine. Overnight at ibis Styles Katherine. **(B)**

Day 6: Katherine

Enjoy a cruise through beautiful Katherine (Nitmiluk) Gorge this morning (own expense). Travel to the town of Mataranka and visit Mataranka Homestead and the crystal clear waters of Mataranka Thermal Pool. Overnight at ibis Styles Katherine.

Day 7: Katherine to Litchfield National Park (227km)

Travel north to Batchelor and into Litchfield National Park, one of the Top End's most accessible natural attractions. Overnight at Batchelor Resort.

Day 8: Litchfield National Park to Darwin (113km)

Enjoy more time exploring Litchfield National Park before continuing to Darwin via Territory Wildlife Park (own expense). Darwin is the perfect place to end your adventure. Don't miss the pink, purple and orange hues of a Darwin Harbour sunset!

The car is booked until tomorrow and should be dropped off at the city or airport by the same time as it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

Experience the outback adventure of a lifetime on a 4WD journey along the famous Gibb River Road. Visit pioneering towns, explore fascinating national parks and witness spectacular scenery as you travel along the unsealed, former stock route.

Day 1: Broome to Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge (437km)

Pick up your 4WD vehicle from Broome and drive to Derby. Continue via Windjana Gorge to Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge, a fantastic base for exploring the Gibb River Road's magnificent gorges. Overnight at Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge. **(D)**

Day 2: Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge

Spend the day exploring some of the Kimberley's most scenic gorges. Enjoy hiking and swimming beneath the waterfall in Bell Gorge, see rock art in Galvans Gorge or swim at Barnett River Gorge. Overnight at Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge. **(BD)**

Day 3: Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge to El Questro Wilderness Park (480km)

Explore Galvans, Manning and Barnett Gorges and continue to the one million acre El Questro Station. Overnight at Emma Gorge Resort, El Questro Wilderness Park. **(B)**

Day 4: El Questro Wilderness Park

Relax and explore El Questro. Discover Zebedee Thermal Springs, Champagne Falls and Chamberlain Gorge. Overnight at Emma Gorge Resort, El Questro Wilderness Park.

Day 5: El Questro Wilderness Park to Kununurra (85km)

Travel to Kununurra to stock up on supplies. Enjoy a scenic cruise to Lake Argyle (own expense), browse the Argyle diamond showrooms and watch the sun set from Kelly's Knob Lookout. Overnight at ibis Styles Kununurra.

Day 6: Kununurra to Bungle Bungles (326km)

Continue to the safari camp within Purnululu National Park. Allow three hours for the 53 kilometre journey from the highway turn-off. Overnight at Bungle Bungle Safari Camp. **(D)**

Day 7: Bungle Bungles to Halls Creek (163km)

Early start to visit Echidna Chasm then depart Purnululu and travel to Halls Creek via the Great Northern Highway. Visit China Wall and Palm Springs. Overnight at Kimberley Hotel, Halls Creek. **(B)**

Day 8: Halls Creek to Fitzroy Crossing (290km)

Continue along the highway to Fitzroy Crossing, gateway to Geikie Gorge. Overnight at Fitzroy River Lodge.

Day 9: Fitzroy Crossing to Broome (390km)

Take a boat cruise through Geikie Gorge (own expense) before the journey back to Broome.

The 4WD is booked until tomorrow and should be dropped off by the same time as it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.
