5 Day Red Centre Highlights Adelaide to Uluru (Ayers Rock)



Day 1: The Ghan Adelaide to Alice Springs

After boarding The Ghan in Adelaide, enjoy a light lunch as the train travels north towards the Spencer Gulf and Port Augusta. Overnight on board The Ghan. **(LD)**

Day 2: Alice Springs

Wake up to views of the Red Centre and enjoy breakfast and lunch on board the train before your arrival in Alice Springs. Transfer to the hotel then the afternoon is free to explore the town or just relax. Overnight at ibis Styles Alice Springs Oasis. **(BL)**

Day 3: Alice Springs

This morning, enjoy a guided tour into magnificent Standley Chasm, a deep red cleft rising 80 metres. See the immense cliffs of quartzite at Simpsons Gap. Enjoy a light lunch before returning to Alice Springs. Overnight at ibis Styles Alice Springs Oasis. **(BL)**

Day 4: Alice Springs to Uluru (Ayers Rock)

Depart Alice Springs and travel through the West MacDonnell and James ranges. Stop at a camel farm for an optional camel ride (own expense). Travel to the 36 immense rock domes of Kata Tjuta. Enjoy a guided walk into Walpa Gorge before travelling to the Uluru sunset viewing area to watch the sunset and the kaleidoscope of colours that make Uluru. Overnight at Voyages Desert Gardens Hotel, Ayers Rock Resort. **(B)**

Day 5: Uluru (Ayers Rock)

Rise early and return to Uluru to watch the amazing sunrise. Tour the base of Uluru, before a guided walk to Mutitjulu waterhole. Visit the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre and learn about Aboriginal culture. Your tour concludes at Ayers Rock Resort or the airport.
