5 Day South East Splendour Sydney to Melbourne

Visit historic towns, national parks and beautiful lakes as you discover the splendours of the southeast.

Day 1: Sydney to Canberra (286km or 315km)

There is a choice of two driving routes today. The shorter one takes you directly to Canberra via the Hume and Federal Highways. The more scenic but slightly longer route takes you firstly south through the Royal National Park and onto the Grand Pacific Drive with spectacular coastal scenery. Canberra is home to many galleries. Overnight at Mercure Canberra.

Day 2: Canberra to Merimbula (335km)

Travel to Queanbeyan and on to the historical village of Braidwood. Continue on to Batemans Bay, a picturesque

coastal village known for its crayfish and oysters. Travel south from Batemans Bay on Highway One to Narooma, a popular fishing resort, then on to Merimbula. Overnight at Comfort Inn Merimbula.

Day 3: Merimbula to Lakes Entrance (268km)

Travel through Eden and explore the Ben Boyd National Park and Eden Whaling Museum. Driving along Princes Highway you will pass Cann River and Orbest, situated on the banks of the Snowy River, before travelling on to Lakes Entrance – a unique area with rivers, lakes and lagoons joining 90 Mile Beach. Overnight at Comfort Inn & Suites Emmanuel, Lakes Entrance.

Day 4: Lakes Entrance to Phillip Island (315km)

Travel south to Sale, a supply and residential centre for the Bass Strait oil fields, and through the lush pastoral hills of Gippsland. From Wonthaggi enjoy coastal scenery all the way to Phillip Island, home to Australia's famous Little penguins. The 'Penguin Parade' occurs each evening at sunset and should not be missed (own expense). Overnight at Ramada Resort Phillip Island.

Day 5: Phillip Island to Melbourne (142km)

Take the short two hour drive to Melbourne. The car is booked until the following day and should be dropped off at the city or airport by the same time as it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

5 Day Wollongong and Beyond Sydney to Sydney

Drive through spectacular coastal villages and traverse the Sea Cliff Bridge between Coalcliff and Clifton. Continue along the Grand Pacific Drive and enjoy the stunning coastal views en route to Wollongong, a lively city with great beaches, shopping, restaurants, art galleries and more. Stay the next four nights at Chifley Wollongong.

Day 2: Wollongong

Enjoy the day exploring at your own pace. Enjoy the fantastic views of Wollongong and Illawarra from the Mt Keira lookout. Visit the largest Buddhist Temple in the southern hemisphere, Nan Tien Temple, or stop at Five Islands Brewery.

Day 3: Wollongong to Shellharbour (30km)

On your way to Shellharbour, take a stroll along the shores of Lake Illawarra or discover the lake by canoe. Shellharbour boasts the region's only marine aquatic reserve; Bushrangers Bay at Bass Point. Take a relaxing walk through Shellharbour village then visit Killalea State Park.

Day 4: Wollongong to Kiama (38km)

Head to Kiama and Cliff Drive to view the Cathedral Rocks and the Blowhole. Visit Minnamurra Rainforest before heading through Jamberoo to Saddleback lookout. Travel along Grand Pacific Drive to spectacular Seven Mile Beach.

Day 5: Wollongong to Sydney (70km)

Drive through Macquarie Pass, alternatively take Tourist Drive 9 via Jamberoo Mountain Road to see native wildlife and Carrington Falls. Visit the Illawarra Fly Tree Top Walk (own expense) before heading to Moss Vale. The car is booked until the following day and should be dropped off in Sydney by the same time it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

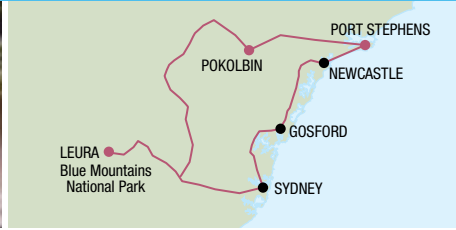

5 Day Blue Mountains and Hunter Valley Sydney to Sydney

Day 1: Sydney to Blue Mountains (100km)

Head west for the Blue Mountains, stopping at Echo Point for the best views of the Jamison Valley and magnificent Three Sisters rock formation. Visit spectacular Wentworth Falls and enjoy a trip on the scenic railway or cableway, or tour Jenolan Caves (all at own expense). Overnight at Leisure Inn Spires, Leura.

Day 2: Blue Mountains to Hunter Valley (275km)

If you wish, spend some more time exploring the Blue Mountains before departing for the Hunter Valley. Travel north through the towns of Mt Victoria and Bilpin as well

as Wollemi National Park to reach the Hunter Valley. Stay the next two nights at The Sebel Kirkton Park, Pokolbin.

Day 3: Hunter Valley

A full day to explore the wineries and gourmet delights of the Hunter Valley. There are wineries in abundance, local artisans and beautiful gardens. Tonight, dine in one of the many gourmet restaurants in the area.

Day 4: Hunter Valley to Port Stephens (160km)

Leave the Hunter Valley and travel north east to Port Stephens. Known as the 'Blue Water Wonderland', there is fabulous seafood and over 26 golden sandy beaches to explore. Take an afternoon cruise with the dolphins (own expense) or book ahead for a cruise tomorrow morning. Overnight at ibis Styles Salamander Shores.

Day 5: Port Stephens to Sydney (220km)

Depart Port Stephens and head south, detouring to Newcastle and past Lake Macquarie. Continue along the coast through The Entrance and Gosford, before travelling into the city and over the majestic Sydney Harbour Bridge.

The car is booked until the following day and should be dropped off at the city or airport by the same time as it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

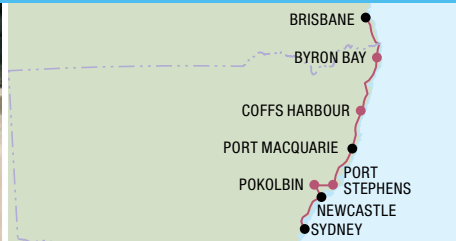

6 Day Pacific Coast Explorer Sydney to Brisbane

Day 1: Sydney to Hunter Valley (216km) Depart Sydney and travel north over the Harbour Bridge and onto the Pacific Highway. Travel via Gosford and Newcastle into the Hunter Valley. With wineries in abundance, take the opportunity to taste and purchase some of Australia's finest wines. Overnight at The Sebel Kirkton Park, Pokolbin.

Day 2: Hunter Valley to Port Stephens (159km) Leave the Hunter Valley and travel northeast to Port Stephens, home to fabulous seafood and over 26 golden sandy beaches. Overnight at ibis Styles Salamander Shores.

Day 3: Port Stephens to Coffs Harbour (335km)

Travel north along the Lakes Way, a scenic route through rainforest with spectacular views of the inland lakes and ocean beaches. Continue on to Coffs Harbour passing through the Manning Valley, Taree and Port Macquarie. Overnight at Country Comfort Coffs Harbour.

Day 4: Coffs Harbour to Byron Bay (251 km)

This northern stretch of New South Wales contains some of the most beautiful landscapes in Australia. From Coffs Harbour, drive via Woolgoolga, Grafton and Woodburn to Ballina, then a further 38 kilometres to Byron Bay. Cape Byron is the most easterly point on the Australian coast. Stay two nights at Lord Byron Resort.

Day 5: Byron Bay

Today is free to spend at your leisure.

Day 6: Byron Bay to Brisbane (166-197km)

Depart Byron and travel north to Brunswick Heads. Continue along the coast via Pottsville Beach, Kingscliff and the Gold Coast. Alternatively travel inland to Murwillumbah then continue on the Pacific Motorway to Brisbane. You can also discover the Gold Coast Hinterland, stopping at Lamington National Park, before arriving in Brisbane. The car is booked until the following day and should be dropped off at the city or airport by the same time as it was picked up on Day 1 to avoid any additional charges.
