Take a journey through regional New South Wales to discover spectacular landscapes, wondrous wildlife, classic outback towns and country hospitality.

A magnet for outdoorsy types, the Snowy Mountains is the place to go for skiing in winter, but has plenty to offer all year round. Go hiking in Kosciuszko National Park and you'll see glacial lakes, alpine meadows, snow gum forests and of course the mountain itself — the highest on mainland Australia — Mt Kosciuszko. The hike to the summit is regarded as one of Australia's best day walks and the pristine alpine scenery is simply breathtaking. For some fun on two wheels, hurtle down the challenging Thredbo Downhill on a mountain bike. More leisurely trails can be found around Thredbo village, Perisher and Lake Jindabyne. Horse riding is also a must in the high country. Ride in Thredbo Valley or Kosciuszko National Park. For watersports enthusiasts, go kayaking, sailing, canoeing, swimming and boating at Lake Jindabyne or check out the indoor pool and giant waterslide at Thredbo. Unwind with a spot of fishing in the crystal clear waters of a lake or quiet stream.

Head country to Dubbo where Taronga Western Plains Zoo is the major attraction. This 300 hectare open-range sanctuary houses more than 700 animals, including many rare and endangered species. Explore on foot or by bike, cart or car. In and around Dubbo there are plenty of things to see and do. Admire the historic buildings, visit the Western Plains Cultural Centre or check out Old Dubbo Gaol. Learn about Australian aviation at the Narromine Aviation Museum, visit the spectacular Wellington Caves or explore Warrumbungle National Park.

Experience more of Country New South Wales where you'll find some of Australia's most historic country towns. Meet the growers and producers at the Farmer's Markets twice a month in Orange. Mining history mixes with motor racing in Bathurst. Take in the Bathurst 1000 or tackle your own Mt Panorama Circuit, albeit at 60km per hour! Tamworth celebrates all things country music and is best known for its annual country music festival.

The outback's vast landscapes offer something different again. Meet the personalities of the outback and experience the best of the west – Aboriginal history, unique flora and fauna, mining heritage and station life. Don't miss the fascinating Walls of China dune formation in Mungo National Park.


