Travel to Split Rock to view ancient Quinkan Aboriginal rock art. Head south east via the Palmer River then over the Great Dividing Range to Port Douglas and Cairns. (B)

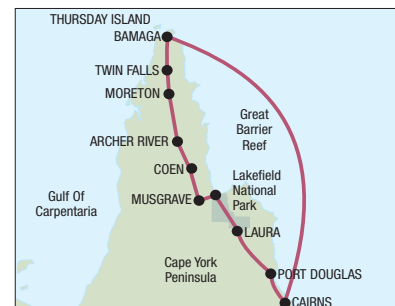

Travel by 4WD along Cape York's rugged Telegraph Track. Cross rivers and creeks, swim, witness giant termite mounds and carnivorous plants. Relax with a swim in the pristine spring fed pools of Twin Falls. Overnight at camp at Twin Falls. (BLD)

Day 5: Twin Falls to Cape York

Rise early for a morning swim before crossing the mighty Jardine River by cable ferry to the tropical shores of Torres Strait. Next two nights is camping on the beach at Torres Strait. (BLD)

Day 6: Cape York

This morning see the beautiful 'Lockerbie Scrub' an isolated pocket of monsoon rainforest, before visiting historic Somerset. Then walk to the very top of Australia – Cape York. (BLD)

Day 7: Cape York to Cairns

Cruise to Thursday Island and enjoy a guided tour of the island. After lunch transfer by ferry to Horn Island to board the flight back to Cairns. (B)

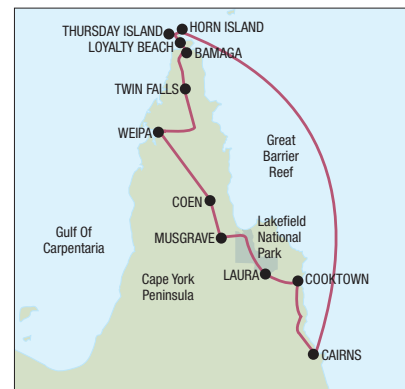

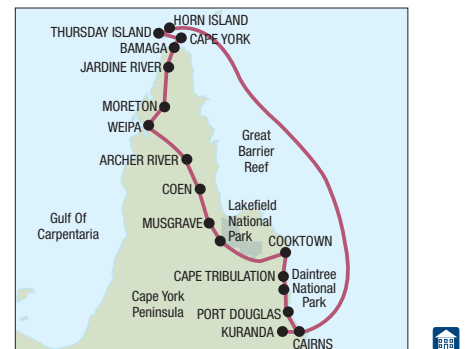

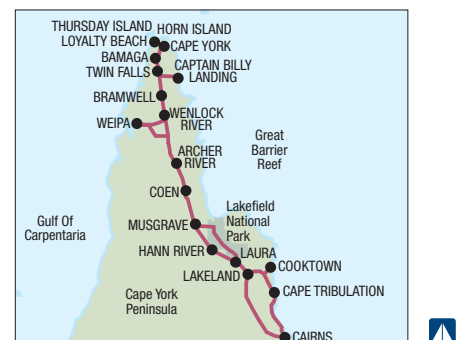
