

### Day 1: Cairns to Cooktown

Travel by 4WD along the coastal drive to the majestic Daintree Rainforest. Cross the Daintree River by vehicular ferry into the World Heritage rainforest. Journey to Alexandra Range, Cape Tribulation, then onto the Bloomfield Track. Stop at Wujal Wujal Aboriginal community to stroll with the Walker Sisters to Bloomfield Falls, then a quick stop at the iconic Lions Den Hotel. On arrival at Mungumby Lodge it's time for a refreshing swim. The next two nights are at Mungumby Lodge, 35 kilometres from Cooktown. (L)

### Day 2: Laura and Aboriginal Rock Art

Travel along the secondary gold route to the Palmer Goldfields, journey past termite mounds and sandstone escarpments into Quinkan country to the Quinkan Cultural Centre for an insight into the region's history and culture. On to Split Rock to view the Aboriginal rock art galleries within the sandstone escarpments. Stop at one of the Kings Plain billabongs and Little Annan Falls before heading back to the lodge. (BL)

### Day 3: Cooktown to Cairns

This morning is at leisure to enjoy breakfast and appreciate the grounds, walks, creeks and waterfalls that surround the lodge prior to departing on the afternoon Cooktown tour. Arrive in Cooktown and Grassy Hill with its expansive views over the northern section of the Great Barrier Reef and to the west, reaching far into the Quinkan Country. A visit to James Cook Museum opens up a history treasure chest showcasing the pioneering of Cape York and its cultural origins before heading to the airport for your return scenic flight. (B)
