






SEE AND EXPERIENCE THE THINGS THAT HAVE BUILT THE CHARACTER OF THIS YOUNG NATION



Our tour will start at Perth in Western Australia on Tuesday, 21st October 2014 with registration and a welcome dinner. Heading east the next day to Quairading to visit Red Poll cattle and then south and more Red Poll cattle, The Dardanup Heritage Park and the Margaret River area for a taste of big gums, wines and caves, ending back at Perth on Saturday, 25th October after experiencing a great one day country show. From Perth you will fly to Adelaide, a mere 2500 kilometers on Sunday, 26th. From the airport a bus will take the tour north to the wine region of Clare and from here visits will be made to Red Poll cattle in Jamestown and the Yorke Peninsula and back to Adelaide to stay on Tuesday, 28th. After the morning to enjoy Adelaide a mid afternoon flight will take the tour to Melbourne.



Victoria will be the first of our Eastern States visited. Here you will not only see Red Poll cattle but Penguins coming on shore at night, the scenic coast road and a good dose of goldfields history with a show at Sovereign Hill called "Blood on the Southern Cross", and visit the historic towns of

Ballarat and Bendigo. On 2nd November on your way to the border town of Albury, the site for our Congress, the tour will visit the Whittlesea Show.

Congress will be a one day event with a lunch and dinner at the Rydges Hotel, Albury on Monday, 3rd November. We would expect many Australian members and interested people to attend and they will be able to book accommodation and register through our tour manager, Sunlover. The theme for the conference will be "Red Polls Making a Difference".

As Tuesday, November 4th is Australia's unofficial national day, Melbourne Cup Day, [the race that stops the nation] we will run a sweepstakes at the Red Poll stud visited this day in New South Wales. After three nights in Albury the tour will head to Canberra, our national capital, via the alpine way and over Australia's highest peak. In Canberra on 6th November there will be a visit to the National War Memorial and dinner at Old Parliament House. This could be a very big day.

From Canberra we travel north to Dubbo and a visit to the unique Open Plains Zoo and then a Red Poll cattle visit before spending a night at Australia's country music capital, Tamworth on 8th November. The next two days are spent in the New England region with a visit to a large commercial feedlot and several Red Poll herds before ending the tour on the Gold Coast on Tuesday, 11th November with a farewell lunch.

Those who wish to depart will be able to do so that evening or if you wish to see more of Australia, Sunlover Holidays will be more than happy to accommodate you. Further information is available from our website, www.redpoll.org.au. The tour can be broken in to sections for those people unable to spare the whole three weeks. If you are coming from overseas then you would be advised to do the whole tour. We look forward to seeing you on tour with us from Tuesday, 21st October 2014 till Tuesaday, 11th November 2014.
