TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

You can visit South Australia anytime of the year. The summer months are hot and dry, perfect for spending at the beach and exploring coastal towns. During autumn, the days are sunny and temperatures are milder. Adelaide Hills is the perfect spot to see fiery red and orange autumn leaves. In winter the temperatures drop and frosts are common. It is also the wettest season; however South Australia is the driest state in Australia. South Australian springs are awash with colour. Trees are a lush green and flowers are in bloom. Adelaide is bathed in deep purple with jacarandas flowering. Roam through the golden fields in the Clare Valley and see the almond blossoms on the Fleurieu Peninsula.

BEACH SAFETY

Australia has some of the world's best beaches, however care and caution should be exercised at all times. Please remember to swim between the red and yellow flags and listen to instructions from lifesavers and lifeguards.

GETTING AROUND

BY RAIL

Take the ultimate journey through the heart of Australia on The Ghan. This amazing rail journey begins in Adelaide and traverses the Red Centre, passing through Alice Springs and Katherine before concluding in Darwin (also operates in reverse). Take the Indian Pacific, traversing coast to coast from Perth to Adelaide to Sydney.

BY CAR

Take the time to explore as you make your way around South Australia by road. Discover rugged national parks, beautiful beaches and country towns from the comfort of your rental car.

Driving conditions in South Australia are varied. Take care when travelling in remote areas during summer, as temperatures in Outback Australia can reach over 40°C. Avoid driving after dark as cattle and wildlife often congregate alongside outback highways at night. Major roads on Kangaroo Island are sealed, however the majority of roads are unsealed and require reduced speed and caution. Travellers should drive at a speed that suits the road, vehicle and weather conditions.

ADELAIDE FESTIVALS

Within the space of a few months Adelaide plays host to a number of major festivals. The Adelaide Festival is one of the world's great art events showcasing internationally acclaimed theatre productions, musicians and dance performances. The city is buzzing during the Adelaide Fringe Festival. In the Botanic Gardens, WOMAdelaide is an annual open-air music and dance festival. Foodies come together for Tasting Australia, be it a collaboration among world-class chefs or an intimate beer and wine tasting. The rest of the state doesn't miss out, with the Barossa and Clare Valley Gourmet Weekends.



WINE REGIONS

Home to 18 wine making regions, South Australia is one of the 'Great Wine Capitals' of the world. Visit Adelaide's National Wine Centre of Australia to learn about wine or discover cellar doors and tasting rooms in and around the city. The Adelaide Hills are known for cool climate wines, from Sauvignon Blanc to Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. The Barossa is home to some of the world's best Shiraz and the biggest names in Australian wine including Jacob's Creek and Seppeltsfield. Follow the Riesling Trail that winds past cellar doors in the Clare Valley or discover more than 50 wineries in McLaren Vale on the Fleurieu Peninsula.



KANGAROO ISLAND

Kangaroo Island is one of Australia's great natural wonders and is often referred to as the 'zoo without fences'. Get up close to native animals in their natural habitat. Watch a seal basking on white beaches, koalas dozing in the tree tops and swim with wild dolphins off Kangaroo Island's beautiful coastline. View the stunning scenery from the impressive Remarkable Rocks, the naturally-formed archway that is Admirals Arch and the giant sand dunes known as Little Sahara. Sample organic honey at the Island Beehive or Clifford's Honey Farm, or try outstanding local gins from Kangaroo Island Spirits.

In McLaren Vale kayak along the Onkaparinga River, indulge in wine and stunning vineyard views, pop into iconic wineries d'Arenberg and Wirra Wirra, or visit new cellar doors like Down the Rabbit Hole.

COOBER PEDY

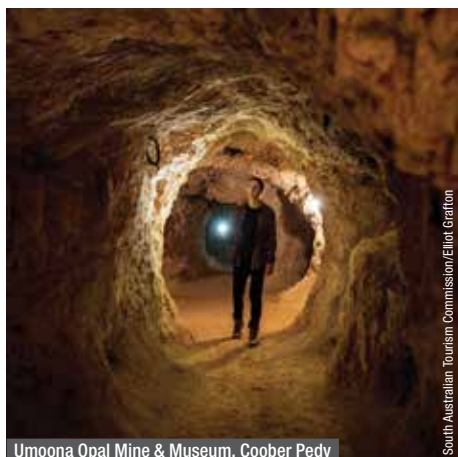
With over 700 opal fields, Coober Pedy is known as the 'Opal Capital of the World'. This fascinating underground mining town boasts a unique way of life. Journey underground and you'll find hotels, restaurants, bars, art galleries and even churches! Try your luck at fossicking for opals at various spots around town. If luck is not on your side, buy up big at one of the many shops or showrooms. Play a round of golf at the grassless Coober Pedy Golf Club, one of the most unusual golf courses in the world.
