TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

Victoria has a varied climate and enjoys warm summers, glorious springs, mild autumns and crisp winters. Victoria heats up during the summer months, making it perfect to laze in the sun and explore pretty coastal towns. The autumn months are mild and see cooler temperatures with many festivals occurring during this period. The weather during winter can be cold and cloudy with frosty nights. Head to the snow fields and hit the slopes over winter. Spring time in Victoria is the most varied with weather quickly changing from calm and sunny to cold and windy. October is the wettest month of the year.

BEACH SAFETY

Australia has some of the world's best beaches, however care and caution should be exercised at all times. Please remember to swim between the red and yellow flags and listen to instructions from lifesavers and lifeguards.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Melbourne and Victoria host some of Australia's most prestigious events throughout the year. Be prepared and book in advance if attending a special event. The most famous event is the Spring Racing Carnival featuring the Melbourne Cup Carnival in November. The Formula 1® Australian Grand Prix is also held in November. See the world's top tennis players at the Australian Open Tennis Championships during January. Look out for the many cultural and food and wine events around the state.

Victoria has countless amazing things to see and do. Here are 10 of our favourites to inspire your wanderlust.





ARTS, CULTURE & EVENTS

Melbourne's calendar is bursting at the seams with major cultural and artistic events and festivals. Dress to impress for the Spring Racing Carnival, take your seat at centre court to watch all the grand slam action of the Australian Open or experience a performance of Harry Potter and the Cursed Child at Melbourne's Princess Theatre. With a plethora of art galleries and museums to explore and major festivals occurring every month, Melbourne offers something for everyone.

GREAT OCEAN ROAD

From rainforests and rivers to old volcanoes and rugged coastlines, the Great Ocean Road showcases nature at its most diverse. Marvel at the limestone stack formations of the Twelve Apostles, see the world famous waves at Bells Beach or laze on the golden sands at Anglesea. Tempt your tastebuds during your journey with fresh produce and excellent wineries surrounding Lorne and Bells Beach. It's certainly not hard to see why this is one of Australia's most iconic drives.





LANEWAYS & CAFÉS

The café scene in Melbourne is world-class. Whether it be during the week or a weekend get together, nothing says relaxation more than a barista prepared coffee and a sweet treat to accompany it. In the CBD, the cobblestone laneways are filled with the aroma of fresh espresso. Further afield, Richmond, Fitzroy and St Kilda offer great café strips with a distinct neighbourhood feel. There's always something new to discover in Melbourne's hive of bustling, creative laneways, with their covert boutiques, famed restaurants and hole-in-the-wall cafés and bars.





WILDLIFE & WHALES

Visit Melbourne Zoo to see over 320 species of animals from Australia and around the world. For the more adventurous, head out on safari at Werribee Open Range Zoo to see zebras, giraffes, hippos and lion prides. If you are looking for native wildlife, make your way to Healesville Sanctuary for a unique, close-up encounter with Australian Wildlife. Migrating whales can be spotted from May to October making their annual pilgrimage at a number of purpose built vantage points along the southern coastline.

MORNINGTON PENINSULA

Breathe in the fresh sea air, sample local cuisine and immerse yourself in the relaxed alfresco lifestyle of the Mornington Peninsula, just one hour from Melbourne. Explore the galleries, spas and cafés in seaside villages, cool off with a day on the beach, or escape to the hinterland for gourmet delights at boutique wineries. Indulge in a relaxing thermal spa in the naturally heated and healing mineral waters at Peninsula Hot Springs. Then play a round on a striking cliff top golf course. The region's diverse array of activities means there is plenty to fill up your days.









PHILLIP ISLAND

Just over 90 minutes' drive from Melbourne, you'll find Phillip Island, famous for its white sandy beaches and high-octane motorsports. Here you will find never ending family fun and an abundance of wildlife. Visit the Nobbies and observe Australia's largest Fur seal colonies or take your place on the raised observation boardwalks and see nature at its finest as the Little penguins make their way from the beach to their burrows. Satisfy your need for speed and get swept up in the excitement that is the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit, the home of international motorcycle and racing car championships.

SHOPPING

Melbourne is undeniably the nation's fashion and style mecca. From the high end fashions of Chapel Street and Emporium Melbourne in the CBD to the stalls of Queen Victoria Market, there is something to satisfy all tastes. Visit the largest shopping destination in Australia at Chadstone. Wander through historic, old world laneways and arcades for those one-off vintage pieces. The city's passion for fashion is a serious matter, a fact not overlooked by international retail giants looking to establish an Australian outpost, and local designers keen on getting a strong start.

GRAMPIANS NATIONAL PARK

One of Victoria's most popular holiday destinations, the Grampians is a series of rugged sandstone mountain ranges and forest. Rich in native wildlife, the national park is a great place for camping, climbing, scenic drives and bushwalking. A network of trails and tracks allows you to explore sparkling waterfalls, spectacular wildflowers and scenic lookouts. Hike to Boroka and be rewarded with a bird's eye view across the park. Visit Brambuk Cultural Centre to experience Australia's native flora and fauna and discover the culture of the local Aboriginal people.









GAME DAY AT THE MCG


Nothing can match the tradition and heritage of the historic Melbourne Cricket Ground. Victoria's favourite sport, Australian Rules Football, was born in this arena and that's why the MCG (or the G as it is known to the locals) is the best place to see your favourite teams go head to head. Immerse yourself in all the excitement of a live game. Dress up in your team colours, grab a pie and a beer and get ready for the action. Four AFL teams play regular home matches at the MCG – Melbourne, Richmond, Collingwood and Hawthorn.

SOVEREIGN HILL

Spend a fun day out and go back to the bygone era of Ballarat's gold mining days at Sovereign Hill. Experience the area's unique gold mining history and try your hand at panning for real gold at the Red Hill Gully Diggings. Visit the 1850s style shops, schools and hotels and see a gold 'pour and drop' into the famous gold mining exhibits. The incredible sound and light show 'AURA' runs nightly and is a must see for every visitor. The Eureka Centre is situated close to the site of the 1854 infamous Eureka Stockade Rebellion.

DISCOVER VICTORIA 4 DAYS

Day 1: Melbourne to Yarra Valley - 98km

Collect your vehicle and depart Melbourne heading to the Yarra Valley. Wineries offer cellar door tastings, sales and have restaurants serving gourmet food and fine local produce. Get close to Australian wildlife at Healesville Sanctuary (extra charge). Overnight at Vibe Hotel Marysville.

Day 2: Yarra Valley to Phillip Island – 172km

Depart Yarra Valley and travel south to San Remo, before heading over the bridge to Phillip Island. The Penguin Parade occurs each evening at sunset (extra charge). Overnight at Oak Tree Lodge.

Day 3: Phillip Island to Mornington Peninsula - 107km (B)

Depart Phillip Island heading around the bay to the Mornington Peninsula. Stylish Sorrento and Portsea are filled with antique shops, galleries, cafés and coastal walking trails. Visit Flinders on the eastern side of the Peninsula and Cape Schanck, the southern most point of the Peninsula. Overnight at Portsea Village Resort.

Day 4: Mornington Peninsula to Melbourne – 75km

Make the return journey north to Melbourne passing Melbourne's beachside suburbs. The car is booked until the following day and should be returned to the city or airport depot by the same time as it was picked up on day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

SOUTHERN OCEAN DRIVE 5 DAYS

Day 1: Melbourne to Apollo Bay – 197km

Travel south west to Geelong and Torquay, the start of the Great Ocean Road. Visit Bells Beach, Anglesea, Lorne and Erskine Falls. Overnight at Comfort Inn The International, Apollo Bay.

Day 2: Apollo Bay to Port Fairy – 188km

See the Twelve Apostles, London Bridge and the Shipwreck Coast en route to Port Fairy. Overnight at Merrijig Inn.

Day 3: Port Fairy to Robe – 291km or via the Grampians 487km (B)

A choice of routes is available. One route travels via Portland, Cape Nelson, Mount Gambier and then on to Robe. The other travels via Penhurst to Dunkeld and then through the Grampians National Park and Mt Gambier before arriving at Robe. Overnight at Best Western Melaleuca Motel and Apartments.

Day 4: Robe to Barossa - 350km

Travel through Coorong National Park to Kingston. Drive through Mannum and on to Mt Pleasant and Angaston. Arrive in the Barossa Valley. Overnight at Barossa Weintal.

Day 5: Barossa to Adelaide - 80km

Explore the Barossa today and visit famous wineries. Travel south through Gawler to Adelaide. The car is booked until the following day and should be returned to the city or airport depot by the same time as it was picked up on day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

GREAT SOUTHERN TOURING ROUTE 5 DAYS

Day 1: Melbourne to Apollo Bay - 197km

Collect your vehicle and travel south west to Geelong then on to Torquay, the surfing capital of Australia. Follow the coast road through Anglesea to Lorne and visit Erskine Falls. Take the scenic Great Ocean Road to Apollo Bay. Overnight at Comfort Inn The International, Apollo Bay.

Day 2: Apollo Bay to Port Fairy - 188km

Travel to Port Campbell, winding through the ferny slopes of Cape Otway. When you meet the coast again see amazing rock formations including the Twelve Apostles and London Arch. Visit Tower Hill Nature Reserve near Warrnambool where koalas, emus and kangaroos can be seen. Travel to Port Fairy and overnight at Merrijig Inn.

Day 3: Port Fairy to Halls Gap - 157km (B)

Drive north today to the Grampians National Park and Halls Gap with its woodland walks, waterfalls and rock formations. Highlights include MacKenzie Falls. Reed Lookout and the Balconies. Overnight at Country Plaza Halls Gap.

Day 4: Halls Gap to Ballarat - 140km

Visit the town of Stawell, home of the Stawell Gift. Australia's richest footrace. Explore the surrounding areas and some of the fabulous wineries, such as Montara Estate. On the way stop off at Ararat and Beaufort, before arriving at Ballarat, Victoria's largest inland city. It is famous for being the site of the world's largest deposit of alluvial gold. A must see is Sovereign Hill, a recreation of what life was like in the town during the gold rush. Overnight at Best Western Plus Ballarat Suites.

Day 5: Ballarat to Melbourne - 114km

Before leaving Ballarat, a visit to The Ballarat Wildlife Park will bring you back into the present with a close encounter with native fauna (extra charge). From Ballarat travel via Daylesford on the return journey into Melbourne. Spa country at Daylesford and Hepburn Springs will offer a great finale to your road trip. This region is famous for the health-giving mineral spring waters that bubble naturally to the surface. Massages, beauty treatments and pampering are always on the agenda along with renowned restaurants and cafés serving locally sourced and seasonal produce.

The car is booked until the following day and should be returned to the city or airport depot by the same time as it was picked up on day 1 to avoid any additional charges.

TOURING THE MURRAY 7 DAYS

Day 1: Melbourne to Echuca - 221km

Collect your vehicle from Melbourne and travel to Echuca, location of the world's largest fleet of paddlesteamers. Stay the next two nights at Echuca Nirebo Motel

Day 2: Echuca

Relax on the deck of a paddlesteamer, try watersports or browse the cafés, shops and restaurants of Echuca.

Day 3: Echuca to Swan Hill - 155km

Half an hour from Echuca is the Barmah State Forest, home to the Barmah Wetlands and one of the biggest stand of river red gum remaining on earth. Travel to Swan Hill with its colonial past on display at the Pioneer Settlement living museum (extra charge). Take a ride on a paddlesteamer, a horse drawn carriage and vintage car. Overnight at Best Western Travellers Rest

Day 4: Swan Hill to Mildura - 223km

Journey from river bushland to a stunning desert environment. Mildura is a charming oasis with citrus groves and vineyards and is home of Stefano De Pieri's famous restaurant. Sample the array of fresh food and wine at local wineries, farm gates and markets. Stay the next two nights at Quality Hotel Mildura Grand.

Day 5: Mildura

Explore Mildura and its surrounding area. Visit the Murray-Sunset National Park, Victoria's second largest national park with its abundant wildlife and colourful wildflowers. Alternatively, travel to Mungo National Park and learn of the Aboriginal history throughout the area.

Day 6: Mildura to Ballarat - 453km

Travel to Ballarat and follow the sections of the Goldfields Tourist Route which take in important heritage sites and wineries. Visit Sovereign Hill and see a re-creation of life during the gold rush era (extra charge). See the colourful costumes and horsedrawn vehicles along the Main Street and visit the various shops including grocers, candle makers, blacksmiths and jewellers. Overnight at Best Western Plus Ballarat Suites.

Day 7: Ballarat to Melbourne - 114km

Return to Melbourne at leisure.

The car is booked until the following day and should be returned to the city or airport depot by the same time as it was picked up on day 1 to avoid any additional charges.


MONIES NOT HELD ON TRUST
